

TSBAMEC Health Commission January Newsletter Submission

Happy New Year, Church Family! We pray that your holiday season was healthy, joyful and memorable.

Respiratory-Like-illnesses: The CDC reports that VA is seeing a significant increase in people who visit the emergency room or an urgent care center with symptoms. The VA Department of Health maintains multiple <u>databases</u> that track infectious diseases and their effect on the citizens of this Commonwealth. For the week ending 12/23/23, the number of adults that were diagnosed with influenza increased by 30% from the prior week. COVID-19 cases increased by 27%. Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) cases are also tracked, and the incidence remains higher than expected. Interestingly, the majority of outbreaks, (when 2 or more persons are infected after a known exposure) have been reported in the central areas of Virginia, including the greater Richmond region.

Because of these statistics, the Health Commission of TSB <u>strongly</u> recommends vigorous handwashing, resuming social distancing, and donning a mask in public. This is emphasized for people at both ends of the age spectrum. The highest number of flu cases is being reported in the 5-18 y/o demographic (in VA). Remember, the current strain of COVID-19 is extremely contagious! The CDC estimates that there have been at least 7.1 million illnesses, 73,000 hospitalizations, and 4,500 deaths from flu so far this season. Do whatever you can to avert these infections!
